Enrollment Fee	Returning student	\$40 per enrollment	To cover a portion of the cost associated with continued enrollment in the preschool program	Student cannot re-enroll in preschool program
Classroom Fee	Classroom supplies	\$35 per year	To cover a portion of the cost of supplies that are expendable and consumable and/or items the school will retain after the class. This fee replaces school supply lists and parent purchased school supplies.	The required items and/or materials or a comparable alternative will be provided. Students will not be excluded from the class or classroom activities if the fee is unpaid.
Classroom Fee	Consumable material	\$35 per year	To cover actual cost of consumable material used by the student in the classroom and/or are items school will retain after the class. Course Fee	Field Trip Fee	Varies by field trip – See school website or field trip sponsor	To cover cost or a portion of the cost of admission and transportation. Fee is relative to cost of field trip.	A comparable alternative may be provided. With prior arrangement, a student who desires to participate in class field trip will not be excluded if the fee is unpaid
User Fee	District issued personal mobile technology device	\$50 per school year	To offset a portion of the cost of devices and to insure against theft, damage, and loss	Student will not be issued a personal mobile technology device
